The refundable fee must be paid either by BACS or cheque five working days before the commencement of the workshop/course.

Following attendance to your workshop/course we will contact you with details for you to either claim back your refundable £10.00 fee or offer it as a donation to The Aylsham Community Trust (Families). The Aylsham Community Trust (Families) is a registered charity, donations will be used to provide further opportunities for our trust families to support their mental health and well-being, raise aspirations and engage in family and lifelong learning experiences. Our fee is only refundable to those who attend the full workshop/course duration.
