Maths GCSE

Would you like to brush up your maths skills, with a possible progression route to sitting a GCSE maths examination?

Please come along to the first session to see if this course is for you - there will be no charge if you decide not to continue with the course.

To progress to sitting a GCSE maths examination in May 2020 students will need to commit to attending further blocks of 6 week courses until they sit the examination. Alongside attending weekly lessons, 4-6 hours of home study per week will be required.

The initial 6 week course will continue during 2020, each 6 week course will attract a refundable fee of £10.00.

Learn (or Improve) Your Crochet Skills

Did you enjoy writing stories when you were a child?

Maybe you like reading and would like to experience how stories are constructed?

Perhaps you would like the opportunity to improve your written English?

This course offers the opportunity to try your hand at creative writing in the form of short stories. It is aimed at all confidence levels, regardless of whether participants have written any fiction before, or regularly enjoy writing!

Each week we will explore a different aspect of writing, such as narrative structure or dialogue. There will be opportunities to explore existing short stories, to try new techniques and write independently. Writing can be done by hand or on a laptop - please bring your own laptop. The content of the course will be adapted to the interests and experiences of the group.

Sign Language Taster



A 6 week taster course which will introduce you to British Sign Language in a relaxed environment.

During the 6 weeks you will learn the alphabet, numbers, colours and simple signs which will enable you to build up a vocabulary base week by week. With practice at home, you will progress to being able to hold a conversation with people with hearing loss on topics such as family, work and leisure.

Attendance to this taster course will offer progression to the Introduction to British Sign Language course during 2020 for those who wish to continue.





Our courses attract a refundable fee of £10.00 for the full 6 weeks, which includes examination entrance fees where applicable. The refundable fee must be paid either by cash or cheque to the course tutor on arrival. Unfortunately we are unable to accept card payments. All courses have limited spaces—they are offered on a first come basis.

Following attendance to all 6 weeks of the course you will be able to either claim back your refundable £10.00 fee or offer it as a donation to The Aylsham Community Trust (families). The Aylsham Community Trust (families) is a registered charity, donations will be used to provide further opportunities and support for our trust families.

Some courses will require a non refundable payment for materials, this is clearly stated where applicable.
