GCSE ENGLISH

Jo aims to boost your confidence when speaking or writing in English through developing grammar, structuring writing, speaking and presentation skills.

During the course time can be spent using these skills to prepare CV's, apply for job vacancies/career progression routes including developing presentation and speaking skills.

Following the initial 6 weeks there will be an option to continue with the course to work towards sitting GCSE English in May 2023.

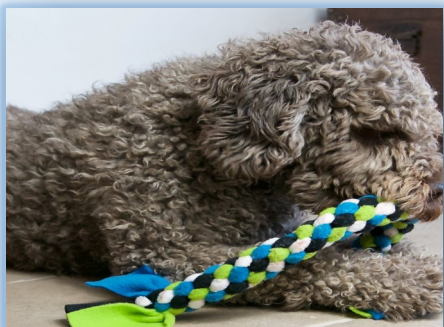

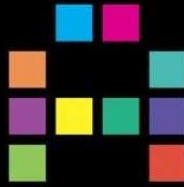
