Our courses attract a refundable fee of £10.00 for the full 3 or 6 weeks, which includes examination entrance fees where applicable. The refundable fee must be paid either by cash or cheque to the course tutor on arrival. Unfortunately we are unable to accept card payments. All courses have limited spaces—they are offered on a first come basis.

Following attendance to all 3 or 6 weeks of the course you will be able to either claim back your refundable £10.00 fee or offer it as a donation to The Aylsham Community Trust (families). The Aylsham Community Trust (families) is a registered charity, donations will be used to provide further opportunities and support for our trust families.

Some courses will require a non refundable payment for materials, this is clearly stated where applicable.
